

Traffic Safety Institute

The Traffic Safety Institute is a division of Eastern Kentucky University that provides traffic safety programs and seminars to reduce motor vehicle accidents and injuries. It also administers and maintains the Kentucky Motorcycle Program that is accredited by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation.

These safety programs are taught by RiderCoaches that are certified by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation and



approved by the Kentucky Motorcycle Program. The RiderCoach certification program is also available at the Traffic Safety Institute.

- All BRC and ERC classes begin in Room 232 of the Stratton Building.
- On-cycle exercises will be ridden at the Leach Driving Range
- Class sizes are limited so early registration is encouraged.
- Successful completion of the BRC or ERC results in waiver of the Kentucky motorcycle license skill test. Successful completion of a course may lead to an insurance discount.

MOTORCYCLE RIDERCOURSES

- A liability waiver must be signed by all course participants. Those under 18 years of age must have the waiver signed by a parent or guardian before taking the course. Contact the Traffic Safety Institute to receive that form.

- During on-cycle instruction, participants are required to wear the following protective gear.
 - A DOT-compliant helmet (Loan helmets available for BRC. Personal helmets must have RiderCoach approval. No half shell helmets used in BRC training program.)
 - Eye Protection
 - Over-the-ankle boots or shoes
 - Long slacks
 - Long sleeve shirt or jacket
 - Gloves, full-fingered
- Additional course dates available for group participation upon request (8 minimum riders).
- A course schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather. BRC will meet Friday evening rain or shine.
- BRC participants must be able to ride (balance) a bicycle before starting a course.
- Successful graduates are eligible for additional practice riding sessions after program completion (additional fee applies).

Proper protective attire is required.

- A course for:
- 1) An experienced licensed rider who wants to renew and practice street riding maneuvers.
 - 2) An experienced rider holding a permit that wishes to receive a license waiver.
 - 3) **Participants are required to bring a street legal motorcycle, proof of insurance, and their current motorcycle license or permit.**



The course polishes riding skills, develops finesse, and emphasizes strategies to reduce risks. The ability to skillfully handle various riding situations through mental preparation is developed throughout the course and reinforced by specially designed on-cycle exercises. Riders can earn a license waiver by successfully completing the optional end of course knowledge and skill test.
